**Topic: Oral Pathology Beyond the Microscope - Role in Dental Practice**

It is the only branch in dentistry that acts as a bridge between clinical sciences and basic sciences. A skilled oral pathologist has trained eyes for lesions specific for the oral cavity and can identify the conditions easier when compared to general practitioners. Being an oral pathologist does not mean merely handling microscopes, but also diagnosing histopathology, molecular diagnostics, teaching, research, and above all has the capability to be a successful clinician.
