# GUIDELINES

- ◆ **Registration fees for Hexis per participant is Rs 150/- (inclusive of GST)** regardless of number of events the participant signs up for. Fees must be paid in full at the venue during registration.
- ◆ Participants may sign up for multiple events provided event timings do not overlap.
- ◆ Registration begins at 8:00 AM and will close at 9:00 AM.
- ◆ Entry is permitted only when valid college ID and a vaccine report are produced.
- ◆ For group events, all members must register individually. Group member list will be noted on the day of the event, as long as all the members have registered.
- ◆ Non-participants are welcome to enjoy the event.
- ◆ COVID protocols such as masking and social distancing must be followed at all times in the premises.
- ◆ All participants will be screened for body temperature at entry.
- ◆ Any acts of misconduct will result in immediate disqualification and expulsion from the premises.
- ◆ The university is not responsible for any misplaced belongings.
- ◆ Judges' decisions are final and binding.

## Rules :

- ◆ Participants are not allowed to open and view the clues prior to the announcement that the hunt has started.
- ◆ Each team will be given a set of multiple choice questions in order to qualify to the next round.
- ◆ Teams must travel on foot. Exceptions will be made for special circumstances.
- ◆ Teams must stay together and work on the same clue. Use of cell phones and other technology is prohibited.
- ◆ Teams are not allowed to seek help from other teams
- ◆ After discovering the solution to the question "who the killer is" with the proof, you will be sent to the final location at which you will be able to give your answer and the game will conclude.
- ◆ If two or three teams report at the last location at the same time, a tie breaking game will be played to determine the winner.
