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A POLICY DIALOGUE ON DRAFT KARNATAKA YOUTH POLICY 2022 - A ROUNDTABLE

Concept Note

The Government of Karnataka constituted a 14-member expert committee to formulate a new Youth Policy for the State of Karnataka. The Draft Karnataka Youth Policy 2022 envisions a holistic development of the youth in the state and empowers them to bring about constructive societal change. According to the policy, the definition of Youth is people in the age group of 15 to 29 years. The policy sees the youth from two dimensions: as individuals and as a part of society. There is a sincere effort from the committee to bring out a comprehensive policy which caters to the Youth of the state.

Key Recommendations

To implement the 2022 Youth Policy, the committee has laid out an Implementation framework which comprises restructuring the Youth Empowerment and Sports Department for structured implementation, Yuva Budget for streamlining the public expenditure towards youth development, and the Yuva Advisory Group for strategic guidance for the youth. For effective monitoring and evaluation of Youth development, the policy is willing to set up a Karnataka Youth Development Index.
