The Directorate of Student Affairs conceived, designed and developed a unique University-orientation programme called Conocerse... for the new students. **CONOCERSE 2020-2021** is a series of Creatively Fun Filled Opportunities for new students to meet their fellow classmates. *It is a Spanish word that means "To Meet".

Two types of events were conducted. The first one was video recording events like 30 seconds Basketball Free Throw Shooting, 30 seconds Football Juggling, Short Movie Making and Public Speaking wherein students had to send the video footage of the activity they were participating in.

The second one was the live events like Virtual Pet Show, Ethnic Diversity Celebration Day and Karaoke Singing Competition wherein students had to come online and display their talent. The judging for these events was done by experts in the field.








Participation


Sports Activities
