

International Day of Yoga 2021

Ramaiah University of Applied Sciences (RUAS) celebrated International Day of Yoga on 21st June, 2021. Three events were organized on the occasion. The first event was an online Yoga session for students and staff of the University in the morning from 8.30 to 9.30 AM. The session was conducted by Shri Nagendra Belavadi, Yoga Therapist, Ramaiah Indic Specialty Ayurveda Restoration Hospital (RISA). He demonstrated body loosening exercises which one should start with before practicing Yoga. Later he demonstrated simple asanas for beginners.

The second event of the day was a Panel Discussion on the theme "Yoga at Home, yoga with Family" from 11.30 AM to 1.00 PM. The panelists were Dr. Gangadharan G G, Director RISA. He spoke on Yoga for Mental and Physical Wellbeing: Ayurveda Perspective. Dr. S N Omkar, Chief Research Scientist Control and Guidance, Indian Institute of Science & Yoga Expert spoke on Yoga Practices for Physical and Mental Health. Dr. Krishnamurthy Jayanna, Professor & Dean, Faculty of Life & Allied Health Sciences, RUAS talked about Yoga as a Public Health Measure for Health Promotion and Mr. Aravind G. Alumnus RUAS and State Level Yoga Competition Winner who shared his experiences on Yoga for Youth. The opening remarks were given by Dr. Anindya Sen, Pro Vice Chancellor -Social Sciences, RUAS. The panel discussion was moderated by Dr. Reema Chaudhury, Director Student Affairs. The concluding remarks was given by Prof. Govind R Kadambi. Pro Vice Chancellor -Research, RUAS.




NSS Poster Competition:

Let's connect... A Virtual OPEN HOUSE Session

An OPEN HOUSE chaired by the top management leadership team for the students all across the Faculty was planned and as a part of this session, the Directorate of Student Affairs was entrusted with the task of conducting a survey so that an overall understanding of students' concerns during this pandemic could be assimilated and addressed effectively during the meeting. The link to the survey form was shared with students and a total of 1473 responses were received.

The overall impression of the students that was inferred from the survey for online teaching was positive though there were some pertinent technical hurdles.

Subsequently an online meeting was held on 5th June. 2021 to discuss and deliberate on the findings and to summarize the action plan to be presented to the students during the Open House. This meeting was presided by Vice Chancellor and was attended by PVC Research, PVC Health Sciences, Registrar, Controller of Examination. Director Academics and Director Student Affairs. A total of 847 students attended the session.

Students appreciated the fact that the University lent an ear to their problems and were satisfied to hear many positive answers to their queries. Many students congratulated their respective teachers who went out of the way to help them during the online teaching mode.
