But it was different. Vilesh entered with his aunt. In his soft, respectful voice, he told in this span of three months, he lost his maternal uncle, his grandmother and the most important person of his life ... his mother due to COVID 19. He continued in his calm and composed manner that this was not the only tragedy that had befallen on him, he lost his father in his early childhood.

I was speechless and was trying to feel what this young boy of 19 years must be going through. But Vilesh was stoic and while narrating his pain, I would feel that he was making great attempt to hold back his tears. Vilesh was wearing a mask and I could not see his entire face but could see Vilesh's two sparkling eyes every time he spoke about his mother. He said ever since his father left them for

heavenly abode, his Aama was there as a pillar to guide and support him. She was a working lady and was living with this dream that one day her son will become a successful professional. Vilesh too wanted to give all the happiness of this world to his mother.

Unfortunately fate had other plans...in a span of 10 days, their dreams, their aspirations and their togetherness got shattered. She succumbed to death due lack of a bed in any hospital on time.

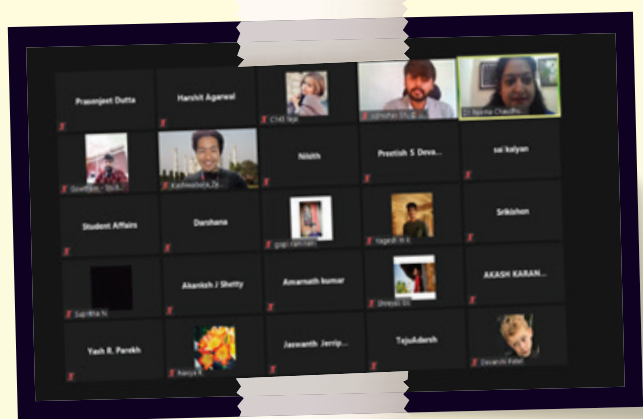
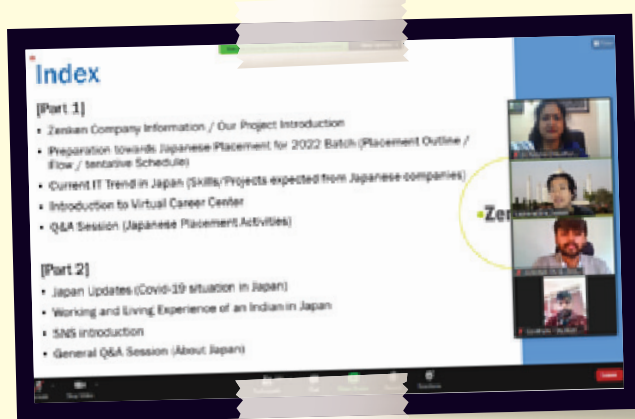

He and his aunt thanked and bade goodbye and left my cabin. I silently wished him all the strength for his life without his Muse...his Aama. I could feel tears dropping from my eyes ...maybe these were the ones that Vilesh was trying to hide.

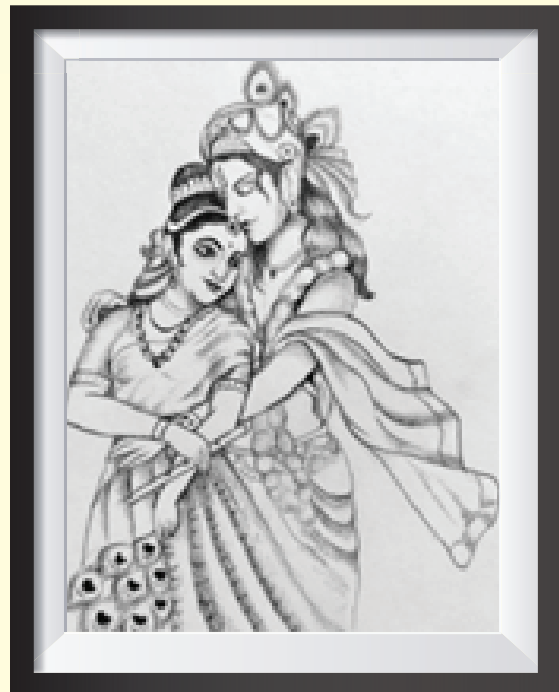
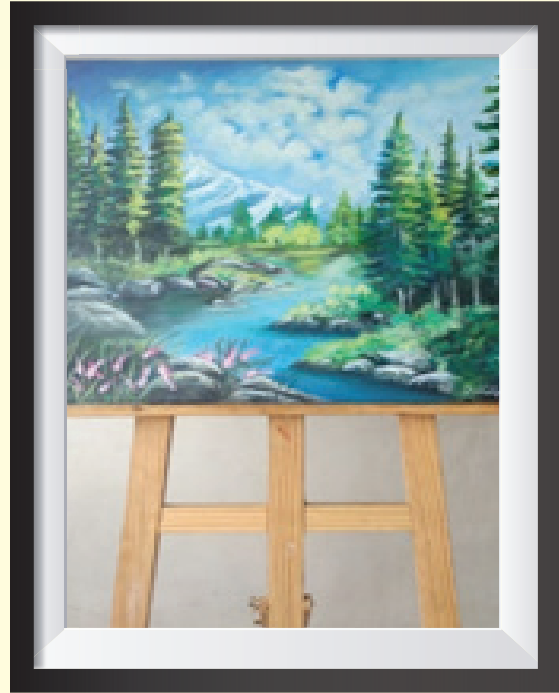
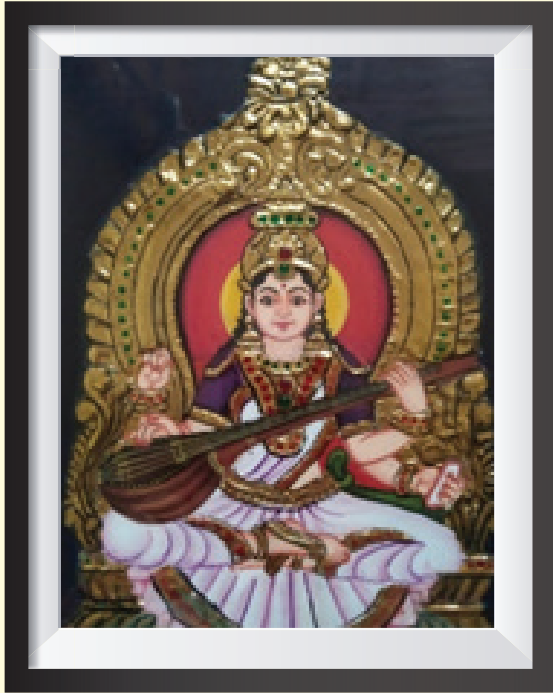
Competition in our University for the first time during Akaira 2019.
