Bengaluru, Prof. Kuldeep Kumar Raina, Vice Chancellor, RUAS, Prof. Govind R Kadambi Pro-Vice Chancellor (Research), RUAS, Dr. Reema Chaudhury Director - Student Affairs & NSS Program coordinator RUAS. Dr. Ashwini Shetty, Dr. Imran Pasha and Dr. Umme Amarah were resource persons from Yenepoya. ## **International Day of Yoga**



When a group of friends had booked a five-star hotel to celebrate a friend's birthday, the manager of the hotel humiliates the entire group for their lack of richness. Pruthviraj went through the search results, but one link caught his eye. It was about stock market trading. He was intrigued by the idea, but lacked capital at the time. He and his friends involved a number of their hostel mates and asked them to pool in a small amount of money in the form of their monthly savings. They pooled Rs. 40,000 in six months, just before the lockdown. During the lockdown they invested this money in the stock market. With the skills they had acquired pre-lockdown and relentless work put in, they got a return of 30% within three months. Within a year, the group had Rs. 1 lakh in their account.

The success they got reinstated their confidence. In the next year with the help of family and friends, they multiplied their capital five times. By this time, they had gotten the hang of trading in the stock market. With the trust they received from well-wishers around them, they surpassed their goal of earning Rs. 4 lakhs by earning Rs. 22 lakhs in a span of three years.

The group had their first ever board meeting in the same five-star hotel whose manager had humiliated them. This time, there was no doubt they looked like they belonged there.

The group of students are currently the directors of their firm, Hostelix Pvt. Ltd. As you read this, they have already made good profits for the day in the stock trading business.
